18. Camp Hotel, 1887. Rebuilt as Beaufort Hotel.
19. Railway Station, 1874. Now incorporating Art Trax Gallery.
20. Railway Hotel, 1874 (remodelled in 1920). Now commercial offices.
21. Butchers, 1867. Now the Pyrenees Advocate office.
22. War Memorial, 1927.
23. Golden Age Hotel, 1864.
24. Cougles Drapery, 1882. Now the local hardware store.
25. Ingrams Harness Maker, 1870. Now the local opportunity shop.
